The Charles Ray III Diabetes Association

The Charles Ray III Diabetes Association was established in 1998 to fill an important need that was not being met by other diabetes organizations. This Triangle-based association provides free medical equipment and monitoring supplies to diabetics unable to afford them.

Since 2002, The Charles Ray III Diabetes Association has provided \$750,000 worth of diabetic medical supplies, including insulin pumps, to individuals affected by diabetes. Proceeds from the Golf Classic will help diabetics better control this deadly disease.

Diabetes is one of the nation's most deadly diseases, affecting 21 million Americans. Those who suffer from diabetes must constantly monitor their blood sugar and insulin levels to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Supplies are expensive and often unaffordable to those without adequate health insurance.

The Rotary Club of West Raleigh

The Rotary Club of West Raleigh, chartered in 1954, is an active service organization that provides volunteer and financial support to a wide range of educational and humanitarian projects. Proceeds from the Golf Classic will support programs and activities such as

these:

- **Rotary Readers Program at Lacy Elementary School:** The Rotary Club provides funding for a part-time reading teacher who works with small groups of students and individual at-risk third graders. Rotary Club members read to children, listening to them read and have lunch with students. The 2008 Golf Classic contributed \$4,000 to support childhood reading.
- **Wake Tech Scholarships:** Scholarships are provided to students in the High School Equivalency Program and Associates Program at Wake Tech. These grants provide critical and necessary financial support for these deserving students to complete their

course of study. The 2008 Golf Classic contributed \$4,000 for education at Wake Tech.

- **Million Meals Program:** The Rotary Club provides financial and volunteer support to Stop Hunger Now. Club members and their families package tens of thousands of nutritious meals for people throughout the world, especially to school children. The 2008 Golf Classic contributed \$2,000.
- **Meals on Wheels of Wake County:** The 2008 Golf Classic contributed \$2,000.
- **The Miracle League of the Triangle:** The 2008 Golf Classic contributed \$1,000.

Since 2006, the Golf Classic has provided \$72,000 to support these and other important programs.
